

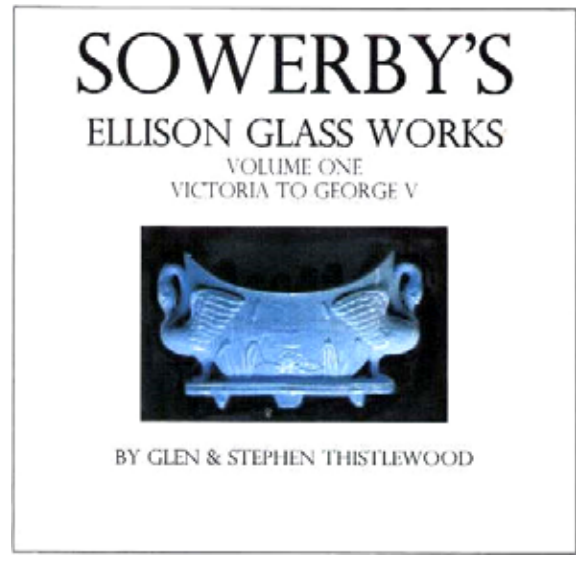

Sowerby's Ellison Glass Works: Volume One - Victoria to George V.

The first in a series of three "electronic books" from glass authors, Glen and Stephen Thistlewood, "Sowerby's Ellison Glass Works - From Victoria to George V" is a new and totally unique resource that contains a wealth of original catalog, text and photographic information on Sowerby. On this user-friendly CD-ROM are almost 100 full pages from 5 different Sowerby catalogs (known as Illustrated Pattern Books) spanning the years 1882 through to 1912.

As well as the original Illustrated Pattern Book catalogs, this volume also contains an analysis of the factory's output plus much detailed information (including photos) on Sowerby's glass colors, patterns and shapes. Further excellent information on pattern inspirations, the factory's history, its trademarks and marketing strategy plus insights on J. G. Sowerby, the artist, make this an invaluable resource for all glass collectors and researchers worldwide. [...]

Carnival Glass collectors will also be delighted to see the introduction of the Daisy Block Rowboat, the Covered Swan and Diving Dolphins within the catalog pages presented. Further catalog pages show the early appearances of familiar patterns such as Pineapple, Sea Thistle and Chunky (aka English Hob and Button).

The CD-ROM will run on computers that use Microsoft Windows Operating Systems and is available only from the authors, Glen and Stephen Thistlewood. **The cost of the CD-Rom is \$24.99 USA. For UK and European Union buyers we need to add VAT and so the cost is £14.99 in pounds sterling.** Postage and packing for USA, Canada, Australia etc., is \$4.
